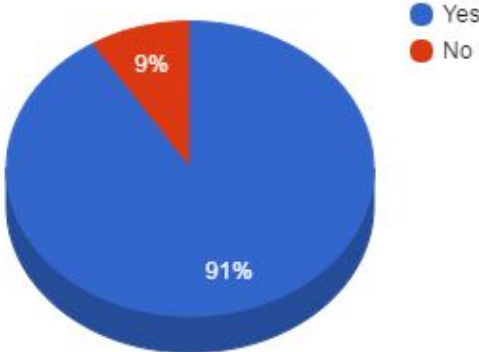
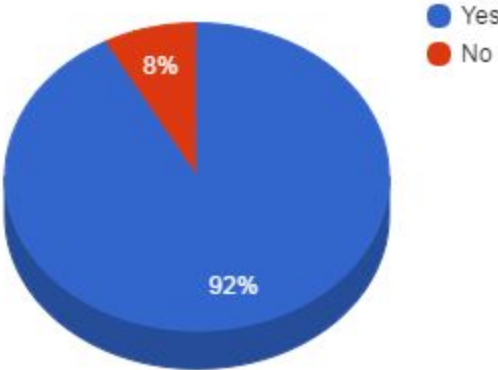


Community Facilities Questions - October 6, 2016

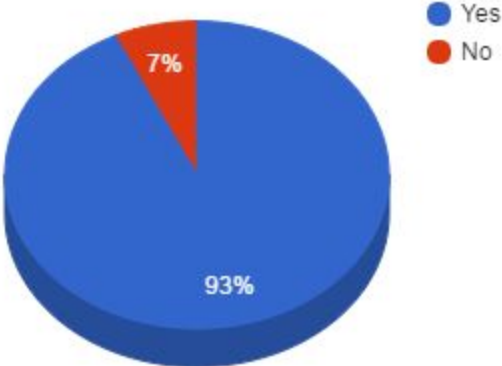
1. After hearing the information tonight, do you think the school is being as clear, up-front and transparent as possible in discussing school facilities? (85 Responses)



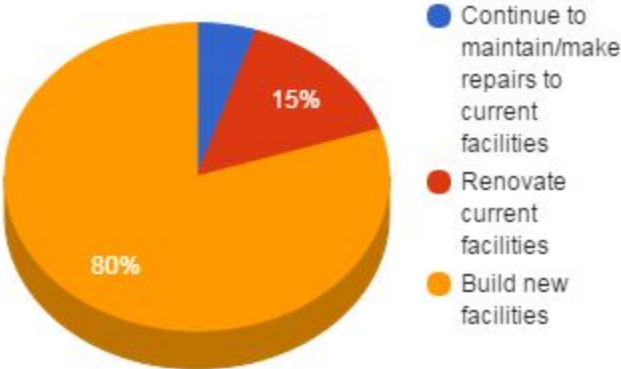
2. After hearing everything tonight, do you feel like you have a better understanding of the research the school has conducted? (83 Responses)



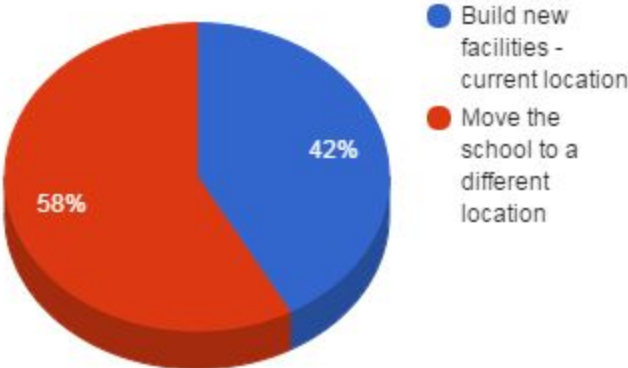
3. After hearing all the information tonight, do you believe the school is being responsible and looking into all feasible options to address facility needs? (83 Responses)



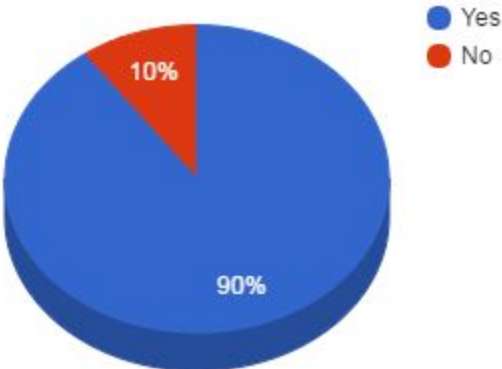
4. After hearing the information about the condition of our current facilities from the experts tonight, do you feel it is in the best interest of the community's children and the community to:
(78 Responses)



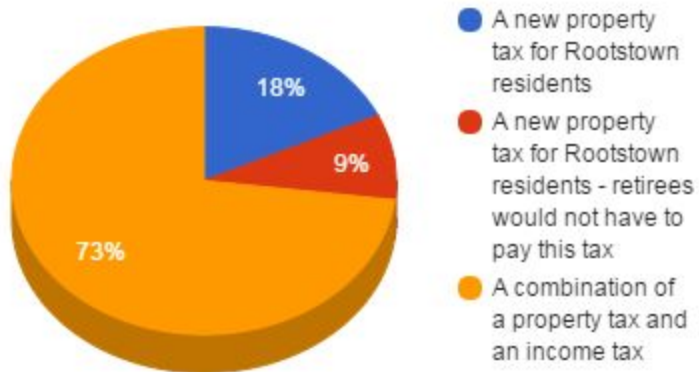
5. If the school were to build new facilities, do you feel the school should: (73 Responses)



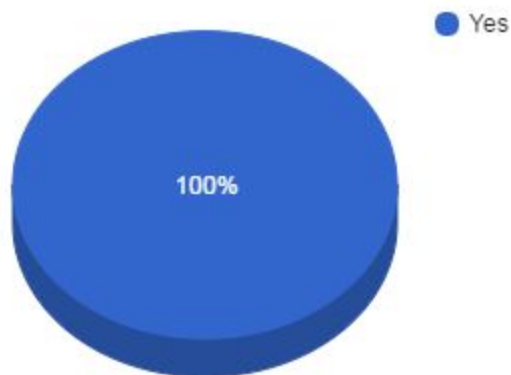

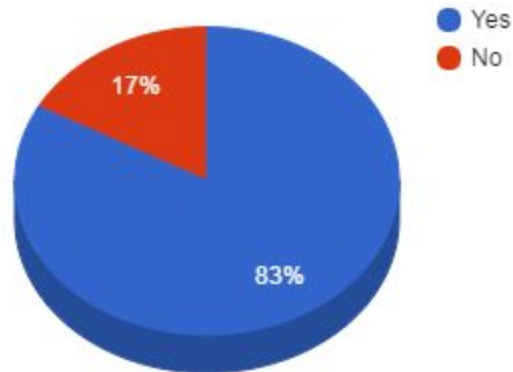

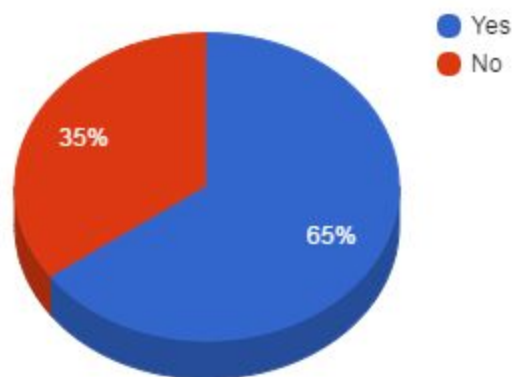
8. Will you attend future community school facilities meetings the school plans to hold? (80 Responses)
